

Conducted "Kingdom Authority and Power" GHN Seminar via Zoom for a Ukrainian Pastor



It was my great joy to teach one of the GHN courses "Kingdom Authority and Power" for Pastor Avilov's family with the Russian version. Pastors Vladimir and Tatyana and their three daughters (Maria, Liza and Anna) are all involved in evangelizing and establishing five new home churches among the poor villages near the Poltavska region in Ukraine. Anna speaks very good English and translated the GHN teaching into Russian. They also provide food, clothing, Bibles, and other necessities to poor children and their families in five different surrounding regions. River of Life Ministries will network with Pastor Avilov's ministries in Poltavska region by providing them with the GHN equipping seminars so that they can, in turn, train many other new converts in the home churches in five surrounding regions. Unfortunately, the Ukrainian government closed the country for another month due to the COVID-19 Pandemic. I was planning to speak at the missions' conference in Ternopil and to possibly travel to Poltavska to minister at home churches established by Pastor Avilov's in September. I am praying that God will destroy the COVID-19 virus soon so that I can begin to travel again and equip multitudes of indigenous pastors with the GHN seminars.









Avilov's family ministering in villages















Pastor Avilov's family regularly ministers and brings clothes, food, shoes, small prizes, toys, and school supplies for orphaned and poor children in five different villages and establishes home groups that will become home churches. Pastor Avilov's family visited a family in Solonitsa village six years ago. Parents were alcoholics and they didn't take care of their eight children. They began to lead the services for adults and the Sunday school for children. Gradually, parents stopped drinking and began to work to take care of their children. After services, he would distribute humanitarian aid to poor people in the village. Then, God asked Pastor Avilov to preach the gospel and help many other poor people in other villages as well. Since then, they have visited over 50 poor villages around the Kremenchuk city and currently they minister at ten villages regularly. Pastor Avilov's family are truly doing the work of the kingdom of God among poor villages in Ukraine. Therefore, I have decided to equip them with the GHN seminar courses via Zoom conference calls so that they can train converted believers in those villages, and to assist them in providing humanitarian aid for orphaned and poor children and families in those villages through Door of Hope Foundation (DHF) whenever we can.
